## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Candidates should have passed the Senior School Certificate Examination (Class XII) of the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi (or an examination recognized as equivalent by the University of Delhi), held in 2015. Where grades are given in school, transfer of grades to marks will be in accordance with the norms of Association of Indian Universities.


## Age requirement - Age is no bar for admission.

For admission to Gargi College, candidates should qualify as per the cut-off percentages declared by the college. There is no 'Additional Eligibility Criterion' for GEN/SC/ST/OBC/PWD categories. All admission seekers should have filled the common pre-admission form of the University of Delhi between $28^{\text {th }}$ May- $15^{\text {th }}$ June, 2015. A photocopy of this form needs to be submitted at the time of admission.

There is no discrimination in admission criteria for Hindi medium students. However, at Gargi College the medium of instruction is English in all courses except in the discipline of Political Science. But students, even after receiving instruction in the English medium in class, may still take the examination in the Hindi medium, wherever question papers are prepared in a dual medium by the University. On being eligible for admission to Gargi College as per the college criteria, the candidate may fill the College Admission form and University Enrollment form on prescribed days of admission as mentioned in the admission schedule and submit it along with the required documents and fees.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Procedure for calculation of 'Best of Four' subjects percentage for Honours Courses (For admission to Arts/Humanities Courses):
a. One Language (Core/Elective/Functional)
b. The subject in which admission is sought (lf a candidate does not include the concerned subject whether studied or not in Best of Four in which she is seeking admission in the honours course, then a disadvantage of $2.5 \%$ may be imposed on the calculated Best of Four percentage).
c. Any two other academic/elective subjects as per List A. (lf a candidate doesn't include the subjects given in List A in Best of Four, then a disadvantage of $2.5 \%$ in Best of Four for each subject may be imposed).

## Admission Procedures

## List A

The following Discipline subjects offered by the University of Delhi for admission to undergraduate courses will be treated as Academic/Elective subjects for the purpose of undergraduate admissions. All other subjects offered by different boards may be treated as non-elective. All the Discipline subjects must have at least a $70 \%$ component of theory exams of theory exam does not include internal assessment/continuous evaluation etc.) in the qualifying exam for the purpose of being treated as academic/elective subject.

## Admission Procedures

1. *Accountancy will be treated as equivalent to Commerce wherever any board is not offering commerce as a subject.
2. Biology/Biotechnology and Business Studies will be treated academic/elective subjects.
3. In case a candidate has studied both elective and core in any languages, then core language will be treated as language, while elective language can be considered as academic/elective subject.
4. Admission to B.A. (Hons) Applied Psychology will be based on 'Best of Four' percentage as in B.A (Hons.) Psychology.
5. Commerce/Accountancy/Business Studies shall be treated at par with academic/ elective subjects for purposes of admission to undergraduate courses.
6. Legal studies may be treated at par with academic/elective subject for purpose of admission to B.A. (H) Political Science.
7. For admission to B.Com (H) Mathematics is must. Business mathematics will be considered equivalent to Mathematics only for admission to B.Com (H).

## Admission Procedures

8. The subject 'Informatics Practices' will be equivalent to Computer Science for admission to B.Sc.(Hons.) Computer Science only.
9. The candidates must have studied and passed Mathematics at the qualifying exam for admission to Honours in Commerce.
(a) For admission to Honours in any language course, advantage of $2 \%$ in the Best of Four percentage will be given to those candidates who have studied the elective language.
(b) In case, a candidate has not studied the language at qualifying exam and is seeking admission to Honours in that language, she will be given a disadvantage of $5 \%$ in Best of Four percentage.
(c) For admission to Honours in English and Hindi, the candidate must have studied and passed the respective language in the qualifying exam and it will be included for calculation of Best of Four percentage.

## Admission Procedures

## Procedure for calculation of 'Best of Four' subjects percentage for B.A (Prog.)/B.Com(Prog.):

a. One Language (Core/Elective/Functional)
b. Any three elective subjects can be chosen. A disadvantage of $5 \%$ on 'Best of Four' percentage will be imposed if there is a change of stream for B.Com (Programme) and 3\% in B.A (Programme)
c. No vocational subjects will be considered.
d. Three elective subjects form List $A$ to be chosen. If more than one non-listed subjects (List-A) is included for calculation of 'Best of Four' than disadvantage of $2.5 \%$ in each subject may be given in addition to disadvantage due to change of stream.

## Admission to Science Courses

The Basis of Selection for Science Physics, Chemistry and Maths (PCM). For Chemistry (Hons.), Physics (Hons.), B.Sc Programme (Physical Science) and Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology (PCB). For B.Sc (Hons.) in Botany, Microbiology, Zoology and B.Sc Progrqamme (Life Science).

## DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION

1. Date of Birth Certificate (Class X Certificate).
2. Certificate of the last examination passed.
3. Mark sheet of the last examination passed.
4. Character Certificate from the school/college last attended.
5. College leaving/Migration Certificate wherever necessary.
6. Certificate of having passed a Board or Class VIII Examination in Hindi (if exemption from Compulsory test in Hindi is sought).
7. Relevant Caste certificate (including SC, ST, OBC non-creamy layer), Disability certificate and certificate from Armed Forces, whichever applicable, in case admission is sought in reserved category.
8. Medical Fitness and Participation Certificates for admission on sports basis.
9. Participation Certificates for Extra-Curricular Activities for admission on ECA quota.
10. One Stamp-sized photograph to be affixed on the admission form.
11. Numbered slip contained in the prospectus of this College, signed by the Candidate.
12. Photocopy of the Common Pre-admission form of DU.

## NOTE:

- Self-attested copies will be accepted.

It is made clear that if any false attestation/falsified records are detected, the student will be debarred from attending any course in the University or its college(s) for next five years and in addition, a criminal case under relevant sections of IPC (viz. 470, 471, 474 IPC etc.) will be instituted against her to subject her to the requisite criminal proceeding.

- The candidate's name in the application form should be the same as in the Birth Certificate.
- Please add father's name/surname to avoid confusion between identical names while tabulating marks at a later stage.
- Indicate your preference for the medium of instruction wherever applicable.

- For Science $70 \%$ theory and $30 \%$ practical component is must, if theory component is less than disadvantage of $10 \%$ in each subject may be given.
- $\quad 1^{\text {st }}$ Cut-off students will be eligible on the last day of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Cut-off if the seats are available . They are not eligible on the last day of $3{ }^{\text {rd }}$ Cut-off.
- Do not send any students to DSW and South Campus.
